Providence Day School – Mosack Athletic Center (“MAC”) COVID-19 Guidelines and Safety
Protocols

Our Moments of Hope community is committed to continued worship services during the course of the COVID-19 pandemic, in a manner that emphasizes the strength of our faith community and our commitment to the safety of each member of our congregation. To promote individual safety and provide an outlet for those with individual concerns for their health, we offer two alternatives for those who choose to worship with us, both in-person and online. Individuals may elect to worship in-person during our scheduled services at the Mosack Athletic Center for so long as they agree to cooperate with the reasonable requests set forth in these guidelines. If you are uncomfortable complying with any of our safety protocols, or if you have any personal concerns regarding your or your family members’ health and safety, we encourage you to attend services from the comfort of your home.

Fundamental Safety Protocols

- If you are sick with any ailment, we ask that you do not attend in-person services and instead worship from home;
- If you are demonstrating any symptoms of COVID-19, including but not limited to a fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, or a new loss of taste or smell, we ask that you do not attend in-person services and instead worship from home;
- If you reasonably believe you have been in close contact with someone who is infected with COVID-19 or who is demonstrating symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you do not attend in-person services and instead worship from home;
- If you are immunocompromised, have an underlying medical condition, or otherwise are deemed “high risk” for potential COVID-19 exposure, we strongly recommend that you worship from home;

Masks and Social Distancing

It is critical that we honor and respect our host’s safety requirements. **Providence Day School requires that masks be worn at all times when inside the facility.**

It is also important that you and your party are mindful of social distancing when inside the MAC. We encourage you to sit with members of the group you arrived with, and that you maintain at least six (6) feet of social distance between your party and any neighboring ones. We also ask that you do not attempt to reconfigure or move any seating in the facility.

Continued Adaptation of Safety Measures and Addressing Individual Concerns

Moments of Hope Church remains committed to reviewing, evaluating, and modifying these guidelines as health statistics, government directives, and facts surrounding COVID-19 continue to evolve.
